A few interesting points:

- Ballyhaunis has a very high percentage of its employment in manufacturing, which is also strong in Kilalla.
- Construction continues to be a big employer of people living in Kilkelly and Ballycastle.
- Commerce & Trade and Professional Services are the two largest employment sectors for many of the towns/villages (Ballina, Swinford, Foxford, Kiltimagh, Crossmolina, Kilkelly and Bangor Erris). These are services (private and public) mainly provided to the local population, people from surrounding areas and tourists.
- The broad 'Other' category is a large source of employment particularly in Ballycastle, Knock, Belmullet and Charlestown. It includes personal services and recreation.
- Public administration is a significant source of employment for Swinford, Charlestown and Foxford. This could be influenced to some degree by commuting.
- Transport & Communications is most important in Kilkelly, Charlestown and Swinford reflecting the influence of Ireland West Airport Knock.
- Agriculture is most important in the smaller centres (Ballycastle, Kilkelly and Bangor Erris).
